#### **Task Overview**

Task: Undertaking Critical/Essential work activitiy on electrical / gas metering equipment, and associated pipework and supply equipment. Demonstrating the use of associated In House Display (IHD) and PPMID.

Location where applied: Customer's Premises.

#### **Key Specific Requisites.**

- No ScottishPower Operative is permitted to undertake any work activity if they, or anyone within their household, are showing any of the symptoms of COVID-19.
- ScottishPower shall, in each case, determine the category of the Customer's condition (Critical Vulnerable / Covid-19 Positive...) and authorise the appropriate level of work activity and control measures, based on this information.
- ScottishPower shall advise their field operatives to download the relevant NHS Track & Trace / Test & Protect app to their mobile device.
